### **ECRB** role in monitoring



#### Monitoring/reporting role:

- Article 5(3): ECRB, assisted by the ECS and the Groups concerned **shall monitor the progress achieved** in implementing the projects on the EnC list ...
- Article 5(6): ...ECRB, assisted by the ECS, shall submit to the Groups a consolidated report for the projects on the EnC list that are subject to the competence of national regulatory authorities, evaluating the progress achieved and expected changes in project costs, and, where appropriate, make recommendations on how to overcome the delays and difficulties encountered. As of 30 April 2026



## **ECRB** role in setting the indicators



- Setting the indicators and reference values:
  - Article 11(9): Every 3 years, ECRB shall <u>establish and publish a set of indicators</u> and <u>corresponding reference values</u> for the comparison of unit investment costs for comparable projects ... in Annex II.
  - Project promoters shall provide the requested data to the NRAs and to ECRB.
  - ❖ ECRB <u>shall publish the first indicators</u> by 24 April 2025, to the extent that data is available to calculate robust indicators and reference values.



# ECRB decision-making role on investment request



#### **Exercise its role upon referral:**

- Article 16(7): Where the relevant NRAs fail to reach an agreement on the investment request within six months ... it shall be referred to ECRB.
- Within 3 months (+ 2months possible) of referral, ECRB shall take a decision.
- Before such decision, <u>ECRB shall consult</u>:
  - **ECS**
  - The relevant NRAs
  - Project promoters



# **ECRB** role in identifying good practices



#### Recommendation:

- Article 16(11): By 24 June 2024, <u>ECRB shall adopt a recommendation</u> (*~statement referring to ACER's Recommendation*) for identifying good practices for the treatment of investment requests for PECI.
- ECRB shall carry out a consultation process involving all relevant stakeholders.
- Article 17: NRAs shall submit to ECRB their methodologies and criteria used to evaluate investments in energy infrastructure projects
- By 24 September 2024, NRAs shall publish methodology and the criteria used to evaluate investments...



# ECRB role on projects under NRAs' competence



- Ensuring consistent application of the criteria and of the cost-benefit analysis methodology (Annex III):
  - Article 2(8): ... ECRB shall check the consistent application of the criteria and of the cost-benefit analysis methodology and evaluate their cross-border relevance.
  - Article 2(14): 6 months before the adoption, the preliminary list of projects (under NRAs competence) and relevant opinions, shall be submitted to ECRB
  - \* By the end of August, ECRB shall provide an opinion of consistent application of the criteria and cost-benefit analyses.
