- Turkish Cypriot community





- Environment, Energy, Transport and Telecommunications




"Peer to Peer" Expertise


Forms of assistance

- Study Visits




Main forms of assistance






Number of Requests since 2009

Activation

Requests are primarily generated by the beneficiary countries

Suggestions from Commission services are also considered



How long does it take?

TAIEX can deliver quickly the requested assistance

On average, from the submission of the application to the dispatching of an expert it takes a minimum of 6-8 weeks

About 10 weeks for the organisation of a workshop



How to apply?

Application forms available via the website http://taiex.ec.europa.eu

Letter, fax, e-mail (under the condition that the basic information requested in the application form is provided) through the National Contact Point for TAIEX



Who decides?

- All applications are submitted for opinion to the National Contact Point (NCP), the EU Delegation and the competent Commission services.
- The European Commission takes the final decision



Selection criteria

The EU legislation (acquis)

- The acquis is the body of common rights and obligations that is binding on all the Member States of the European Union
- For the purpose of TAIEX assistance we mainly refer to the legislation adopted pursuant to the Treaties, particularly in the form of: Directives, Regulations, Decisions



Logistical arrangements

TAIEX covers all the costs related to the provision of its assistance

For Workshops:

- ✓ Hotel and travel costs for EU MS experts
- ✓ Meeting room rental (if in a hotel)
- ✓ Interpretation (including equipment)
- ✓ Catering (lunch, coffee)



Logistical arrangements

For Study Visits:

- ✓ Limited to maximum 3 participants
- ✓ Duration from 2 to 5 days maximum
 ✓ Interpretation (only in exceptional cases)
- ✓ TAIEX covers flighť costs, hotel and dailý allowances for participants

Advisable to establish contact with hosting institution beforehand

Logistical arrangements

For Expert Missions:

- ✓ Duration 5 days maximum
- ✓ No interpretation in principle
- ✓ TAIEX covers flight costs, hotel and daily allowances for EU Member States' expert
