

#### Market reforms still needed





- TSO certification
- DSO unbundinling
- Phase out of regulated generation prices
- Reduce support schemes for socially vulnerable customers to Public Service limits and replace regulated prices by social welfare system support
- Reform network tariffs to ensure cost-reflectivity and eliminate cross-subsidisation
- Make VAT and procurement laws fit for energy trading



### EnC fit for the future – reform needs





- Further alignment of the EnC with EU acquis is needed
  - Network Codes
  - REMIT?
- Reciprocity is needed
- Closing legal gaps
  - "interconnector"
  - Dispute resolution on EU EnC IPs ACER | ECRB TPA exemptions | CBA
  - "PCI PECI gap"

#### Possible solutions





- Introduce "switch-on clause" in NCs
  - E.g. Draft gas SoS Regulation
  - Title III / IV Energy Community Treaty
- ACER Regulation
- Treaty reforms
  - Direct applicability of NCs
  - Reciprocity or eliminate "3rd country clause"
  - Enforcability | dispute settlement


