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Article 12 Solidarity

Article 12, para 4(a)

"The Commission shall by 1 December 2017 and after consulting the Gas Coordination Group provide for legally non-binding guidance for the key elements of the **technical**, **legal** and **financial** arrangements especially on how to apply the elements described in paragraph 3 in practice."



I. Principles of solidarity

- A last resort mechanism
- MS' right not to ask for solidarity or reduce or suspend it based on their own needs
- Based as much as possible on market-based options
- No perverse incentives
- Compensation costs paid by the beneficiaries
- Compensation in conformity with the Treaties, the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union and applicable international obligations
- Proportionality in terms of burden and associated costs
- The framework should provide certainty and security to the actors involved
- Transparency in advance about the likely amounts of gas



II.1. Technical arrangements

- Operational safety of networks
 - Technical possibilities and constraints

Gas volumes or the methodology for their setting

- Solidarity protected customers
- Critical gas fired power plants, if applicable
- etc

Technical solutions

Comments form Gas Coordination Group:

- gas quality related solutions



II.2. Legal arrangements

- Concerned Member States and identification of third country, if applicable
- Competent authority, contact person to whom the notification requesting solidarity needs to be sent
- Comments form Gas Coordination Group:
- Responsibility of Member States, Competent Authorities and gas undertakings
- Conditions for requesting solidarity
- Obligations, e.g. making sure gas is used by solidarity protected customers
- Commitments to pay, clauses
- Arbitration proceedings address 'moral hazard'



II.3. Financial arrangements

• Gas prices to be applied and/or methodology used

Comments from gas Coordination Group:

- Auctions for demand-side response, use of balancing platform?
- 'security call option' (company2company tool)
- Categories of costs to be covered by a fair and prompt compensation; compensation elements; definition of 'fair'
- Calculation method of fair compensation
- Provisions allowing for the calculation of the compensation
- Arrangements for payment
