

National Systems, GHG PaMs, Adaptation planning and strategies available, and Carbon price revenues are all available.



Provision of technical assistance



In person provision of technical assistance:


Offered to the five Western Balkans CPs with nominated lead reporters were sent in the beginning of June. Carried out in-person trainings in North Macedonia and Albania, while Bosnia & Herzegovina has indicated interest at a later point.

Planned:

Continue to offer this to the remaining CPs with nominated lead reporters. Offers to incoming lead reporters from the CPs will also be shared once there are nominations, and it is deemed useful.

Continued discussion with the CPs to see what type of technical assistance could benefit most.

Overview of roles from the different institutions





How to add a supporting reporter



Step by step

- Be logged into Reportnet as a Lead Reporter
- Click "Manage reporters" (1.)
- Click "Add" in bottom left corner (2.)
- Add the supporting reporters email with which they have registered an EU Login.
- Select role as "REPORTER WRITE" (3.).
- Have the reporter log into Reportnet, and notify you.
- Return to this page, and press "Update permissions" (4.)
- The supporting reporter should now have access.







Reporting on National Systems for PaMs and projections:

CLIMATE AND ENERGY IN THE EU

Find information on the EU and its Member States' progress towards their 2030 targets on climate and energy

- Look in the <u>National Communications</u> and the <u>Biennial Update Reports</u> (BURs), both to the UNFCCC, as a starting point.
- Advertisement: Planning an upcoming webinar focused on this topic.

Greenhouse Gas Policies and Measures:

- The Draft National Energy and Climate Plan (NECP).
 - Much information from the PaMs described there can be copied over into the GovReg format.
 - ... But other information also requires adaptation to fit the format, and additional information is also requested.
- The UNFCCC documents mentioned above.



Adaptation Strategies and Planning:

- Starting point, the UNFCCC documents previously mentioned.
- And/or national adaptation strategies/plans.

Revenues from Carbon Price Mechanism:

- Starting point, what carbon price mechanisms exists. The Ministry of Finance (or equivalent) is often involved.
- The UNFCCC documents previous mentioned.
