



Report to the Ministerial Council on Opinions Issued, in line with Article 24 of Regulation 347/2013

### I. Legal Background

Based on the Article 24/Reporting of the adopted Regulation 347/2013:

- 1) "The Secretariat shall monitor and review the application of this Decision [2015/09/MC-EnC adopting the Regulation 347/2013] in the Contracting Parties.
- 2) The Secretariat shall present a report to the Ministerial Council for the first time by 30 November 2016, and thereafter on an annual basis, summarising the opinions issued by the Secretariat in application of the acts referred to in Article 1, as adapted by this Decision."

The Secretariat shall carry out its work based on the following provisions of the Regulation Article 24/Implementation of the energy acquis:

- "Each Contracting Party shall bring into force the laws, regulations and administrative provisions necessary to comply with Regulation (EU) No 347/2013, as adapted by this Decision, by 31 December 2016. They shall forthwith inform the Energy Community Secretariat thereof. The Contracting Parties shall apply those measures from 1 January 2017.
- 2) The Contracting Parties shall communicate to the Energy Community Secretariat the text of the main provisions of national law which they adopt in the field covered by this Decision."

## II. Implementation Status of Regulation 347/2013 in the Contracting Parties

Based on the above provisions, the Secretariat is assisting the Contracting Parties with the implementation of Regulation 347/2013 and monitors its status in each country.

The Secretariat issues a detailed Annual Implementation Report on the Energy Community Acquis, including a chapter on Regulation 347/2013, as implemented in the Contracting Parties. This Report is presented to the Ministerial Council each year.

The Secretariat has identified a number of milestones in the Regulation provisions and use these as milestones in monitoring.

These include:

- 1. Nomination of a National Competent Authority
- 2. Publication of the Manual of Procedures by the National Competent Authority
- 3. Publication by National Regulatory Authority of a Set of indicators and corresponding reference values for comparison of investment unit costs
- 4. Publication by National Regulatory Authority of a Methodology and the criteria used to evaluate investments in electricity and gas infrastructure projects and the higher risks incurred by these.

Each of these milestones were assigned a weighting factor from 0% to 100% and the final level of implementation of Regulation 347/2013 was scored accordingly.

A summary of the 2019 Implementation Report – chapter on Regulation 347/EU is presented below in the two tables bellow.

## III. Opinions issued by the Secretariat

Since the transposition of the Regulation 347/2013, by 31 December 2016, the Secretariat was not requested, and did not issued any opinion.

#### IV. Conclusions

The implementation of Regulation 347/2013 in the Energy Community is progressing slowly. The most advanced is implementation in Kosovo\*, although no single real application of the provisions appears to be enacted.

Most of the Projects of Energy Community Interest and Projects of Mutual Interest are still in the phase of project preparation and not in construction phase.

The provisions will become more relevant when permitting, public consultations, and construction works will be implemented.
