





15th EECG MEETING AND CONCLUSIONS



- 47 participants at 15th EECG meeting all CPs and Turkey
- **♦** CT1&CT2: Transposition of EED (status) and first annual reports; NEEAPs monitoring and reporting:
 - Ongoing partial implementation of **EED** in CPs (esp. in Montenegro and Serbia); there is no fully EED compliant (either new or amended) EE Law in CPs! Draft EED Laws in Kosovo*, FYR Macedonia, Moldova and Ukraine. Georgia and initiated activities! Pending in Albania, not clear in BiH!
 - o **NEEAPs** adopted in all CPs, except Georgia! Albania adopted NEEAP in December 2017.
 - o Presentation of **first annual reports** and assistance (GIZ ORF EE, EU4Energy, bilateral TAs: GIZ, EBRD, EU):
 - Submitted by BIH, FYR Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Serbia and Ukraine,
 - Submitted officially by Kosovo* (07 February 2018) and Ukraine (01 March 2018)
 - Pending by Albania
 - Different deadlines for Georgia (2019)
 - Reports are well structured, follow EED requirements and in line with 2017 EECG template! Some CPs need official submission!

2020 targets: Energy Community's 2020 energy consumption has to be no more than 187 Mtoe of primary energy or no more than 133 Mtoe of final energy!
