Scope

Market monitoring is a core element of regulatory responsibilities. Only in-depth knowledge of market performance, stakeholder activities and development outlooks allow regulators to create an effective market framework that balances the needs of market players and is able to promote competition, customer protection, energy efficiency, investments and security of supply at the same time. The relevance of regulatory market monitoring is not only recognised by the Energy Community acquis communautaire but has also already been in the centre of ECRB activities during the past years.

The Workshop targets assessing the possibility to launch a pilot project of regional market monitoring compatible with the market monitoring activities of ACER.
