## EU4ENERGY FOURTH YEAR WORK PROGRAMME FOR UKRAINE MAY – DECEMBER 2020



### Area 4 Oil

- **Activity 4.1** Support in development of procedure for the nomenclature, quantities, and qualitative characteristics of crude oil and petroleum products included in the minimum stocks as well as rates of natural losses of crude oil and petroleum products and losses incurred due to sampling
- **Activity 4.2** Support in development of a standard form of a reservation agreement (tickets) including draft delegation agreement
- **Activity 4.3** Support in development of a standard form of an agreement for the storage operators of crude oil and petroleum products
- **Activity 4.4** Support in development of a standard form of an agreement for the sale and purchase of crude oil and/or petroleum products from the minimum state stocks – which shall be concluded with the winner of the tender



### Area 7 Improvement of the institutional framework

- **Activity 7.1** Support in organization of High-level policy talks on gas and electricity markets, energy efficiency and independence of the energy regulator



### Area 8 Greater technical, institutional and administrative capacity

- **Activity 8.6** Capacity building activities through support in establishing and operation of the Working group for the reforms in oil stocks sector/workshops/other activities to ensure experience exchange
