five years on

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- 6/2006 – treaty enters into force
- 9/2010 – ecs implementation report
- 9/2010 – mc expresses concerns
- 3/2011 – ecs implementation paper

- deep reforms required to reach treaty's objectives
- #1: market integration depends on reform of market design in each contracting party
 - preference given to domestic production,
 - exclusive relationships between public companies
 - expansion of the captive market in law or in practice

- reforms undertaken in fyromacedonia, montenegro and unmik
- albania, bosnia+herzegovina and serbia currently under discussion



#2: price reform inevitable for creating open, secure and sustainable markets

- universal price regulation contravenes the acquis
- discourages investment, energy efficiency and supply security
- to be abandoned at least for non-household customers

- in view of the new challenges: complete implementation by the end of 2011
- secretariat's contribution ,
 - approach to reporting
 - approach to assistance
 - approach to dispute settlement
 - approach to national enforcement institutions
 - approach to new legislation
