

**PROCEDURAL ACT  
OF THE ENERGY COMMUNITY SECRETARIAT**

**2024/07/ECS-EnC on establishing the Renewable Energy Task Force**

The Energy Community Secretariat ("the Secretariat"),

Considering the critical importance of implementing policies and legislation in the field of renewable energy in line with the EU best practices and acquis binding in the Energy Community, while fostering the integration of renewable energy sources,

Determined to strengthen efforts in renewable energy deployment to meet energy and climate policy objectives,

Recognizing the need for coordination of Secretariat's technical expertise and capacity building to navigate the evolving renewable energy landscape, by common efforts of different units of the Secretariat, including the European Green Deal Unit, Legal Unit, Electricity Unit, Gas Unit, ECRB Unit and Project Management Unit,

Based on Article 67(e) of the Treaty,

**ADOPTS THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURAL ACT:**

Article 1

**Establishment of the Task Force**

1. The Renewable Energy Task Force (hereinafter referred to as "the Task Force") is hereby established within the Secretariat.
2. The purpose of the Task Force is to coordinate and streamline the Secretariat's activities, providing support to and collaborating with the Contracting Parties on better implementation of acquis in the field of renewable energy.
3. Main responsibility of the TF:
  - Monitor and assist in proper transposition and implementation of the Renewable Energy Directive in the Contracting Parties;
  - Facilitate coordination within the Secretariat, with the European Commission, the donors and international organizations and with the Contracting Parties on matters related to Renewable Energy Directive;
  - Lead the activities of the Renewable Energy Coordination Group and oversee the implementation of the biannual Work Programme;
  - Advance the implementation of the regional project on guarantees of origin (GOs) and support the integration process into the EU;

- Collaborate with the private sector to enhance renewable energy investments through Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs);
- Organize an annual renewable energy conference to bring together representatives from national ministries, regulators, TSOs, DSOs, financiers, power utilities, project developers, and corporations to discuss and navigate renewable energy developments.

## Article 2

### **Management of the Task Force**

1. The Senior Renewable Energy Expert from the European Green Deal Unit shall serve as the Task Force Lead and coordinate the activities of the Task Force.
2. The Task Force should operate under the oversight of the Head of European Green Deal Unit who will remain responsible for the supervision of the results of the work coordinated by the Task Force Lead.
3. The Task Force shall be comprised of the Task Force Lead, Renewable Energy Expert from the European Green Deal Unit and officials of the Secretariat delegated in particular by the following units:
  - a. Legal Unit,
  - b. Electricity Unit
  - c. Gas Unit.
  - d. ECRB Unit.
  - e. Project Management Unit.

## Article 3

### **Entry into force**

This Procedural Act enters into force on the day of its adoption.
