



# TF1: Retail Market Monitoring





- Market Monitoring Report on the functioning of gas and electricity retail markets in EnC CPs
  - Three detailed questionnaires used again (electricity, gas and customer protection)
  - Data collection in the final stage
  - Some clarifications would be needed
  - Draft report to be prepared by September 2020
- Input to the annual market monitoring report of ACER-CEER on retail market developments
  - NRAs completed questionnaire on electricity and gas offer breakdowns of household prices
  - WG agreed for ECS to share additional data with ACER and CEER (retail markets' concentration and structure, switching, comparison tools, vulnerable customers etc.)




### 3rd Trilateral CEER-ECRB-MEDREG Workshop

- Agenda prepared and approved
- Scheduled for 28 May 2020, Vienna
- Due to corona pandemic, WS is postponed
- 28 May 2020: CEER-ECRB-MEDREG informal meeting (videoconference) of the customer WGs chairs + representatives of three secretariats and coordination contacts
  - Mutual institutional cooperation in the context of consumer protection/involvement and retail markets
  - Opportunity to advance dialogue on topics of common interests
  - Key message: collaboration doesn't stop despite the current challenging circumstances!

# TF3: Quality of Supply





## Joint CEER-ECRB benchmarking report on QoS

- Special TF established (Commercial quality, Voltage quality & Continuity of supply, Gas quality)
- Close contact with CEER (joint sessions of ECRB CRM WG and CEER QoS TF)
  - Data collected
  - Joint sessions of the drafting team (two TFs) in 2020: Vienna 23-24 Jan and Brussels 3-4 March (Skopje 2 April postponed)
  - Drafting team continued to meet regularly online
  - Expected delay in finalizing deliverables due to the pandemic
  - Some clarifications would be required from NRAs

# TF4: Digital Channels of Communications





Report on the next generation of customers and digital channels of communications in the Contracting Parties

- Assessment of the digitalized level of customer service and digital channels of communications provided by regulators and utilities
- Guidance and recommendations for necessary steps that have to be taken for further development and support of digital services
  - Questionnaire prepared
  - Data collection in the final stage
  - NRAs to provide clarification when requested
  - Draft report to be prepared by October 2020

## TF5: E–Mobility





Survey on legal, regulatory, technical and economic aspects of e-mobility

- Legal, regulatory, technical and economic aspects to be analysed
- Special emphasis on procedures in construction and operation of infrastructure for electric vehicle
  - Questionnaire on e-mobility prepared
  - Required inputs provided by all CP NRAs + RAE (ERE announced its response as soon as possible)
  - NRAs to provide clarification when requested
  - Draft report to be prepared by October 2020
