Re-stablish (once promising) gas market

- Necessary roadmaps for reforms
- Investigate better alternatives to secure gas supplies
- Rectify non compliances
- Reduce state intervention



Strategic actions and Recommendations

- The post-2024 (no) transit outlook
- Unlocking storage business opportunities
- Exploring (untapped) biomethane production; green hydrogen in the future

Recommendations

- Roadmaps for abolishing the export ban on gases (including renewable gases)
- Roadmap to reform the PSO
- Implementation of Network codes (BAL, TAR, etc) and SoS acquis
- DSO sector: ensure unbundling; cost-reflective tariffs new model for DSOs
- Adopt decarbonisation/H2 strategies /framework for biogases
- Future of infrastructure in a (more) decarbonised sector new business model for network operators
