Background

This is the third in a series of workshops dedicated to technical consultations on the delegated and implementing acts that supplement RED II. These acts provide guidance and detailed methodologies for verifying the sustainability and greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions savings criteria for biofuels, bioliquids, and biomass fuels.

The purpose of the workshops is to introduce the relevant acts and provide technical clarifications. The outcomes of these technical consultations will be taken into account in the adaptation process. Draft adapted versions of the acts will be shared with the RECG members prior to the proposal for their adoption, at which point Contracting Parties will have the opportunity to submit written feedback.

Building on the first and second workshops held in July and November 2025, this third session will focus on Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/996, which lays down rules on verification of compliance with the sustainability and greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions saving criteria and the low indirect land-use change (ILUC)-risk criteria. This act covers a broad range of provisions, including those governing the operation of Voluntary Schemes, and sets out obligations for both economic operators and Contracting Parties.

RECG members are therefore invited to share this invitation with relevant technical experts from institutions that are involved—or are expected to be involved following the full transposition of RED II—in implementing the system for verifying compliance with the sustainability and GHG emissions savings criteria.
