

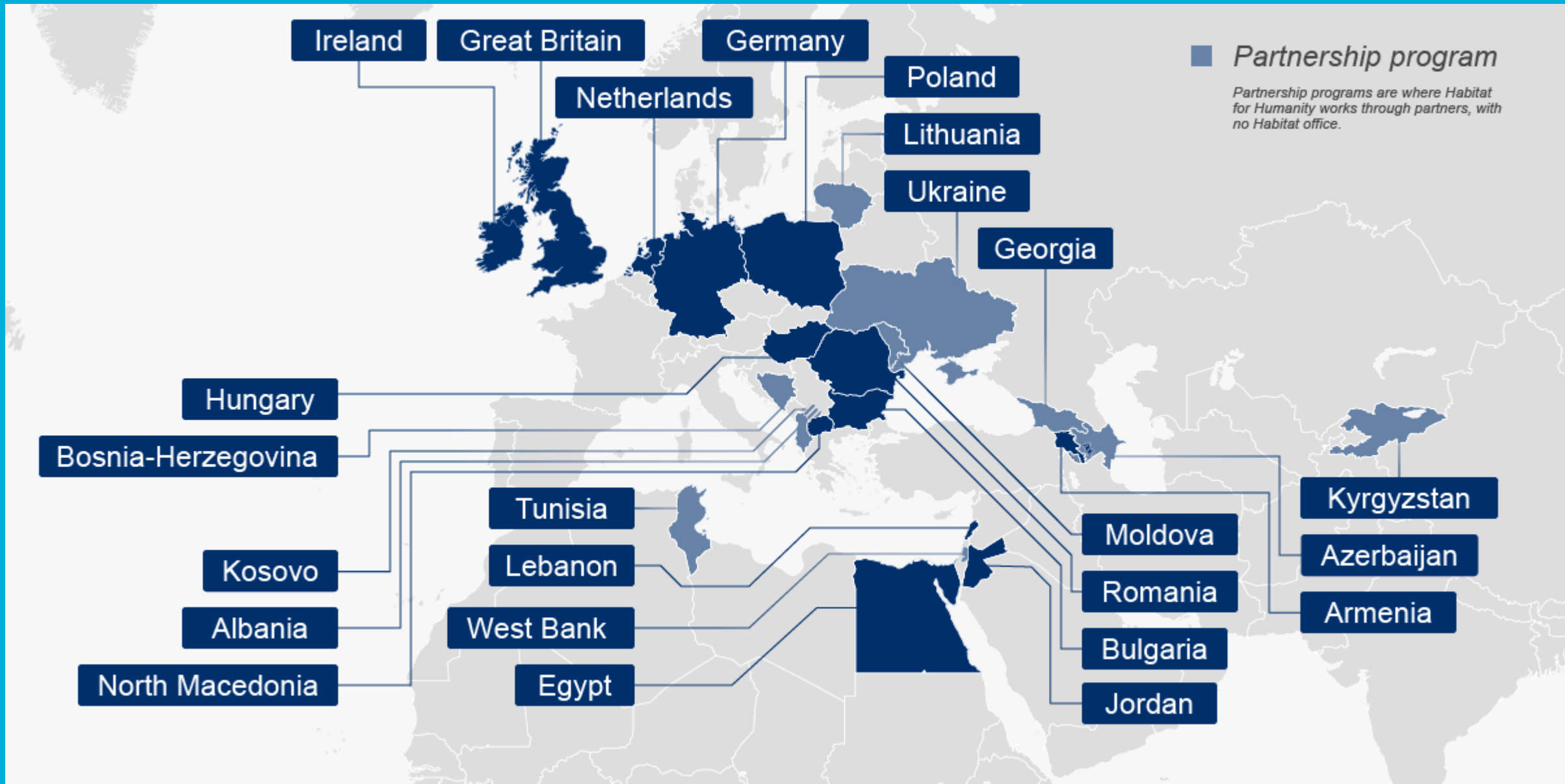


Social aspects of EE in Housing sector – HFHI European Regional projects

Energy Resilience program priorities (what):

- Addressing energy poverty
- Residents in MAB's
- Focusing on support of Home-Owners Associations
- Trough energy efficiency, renewable energy measures



Regional footprint:

- West Europe, Central Eastern Europe, and the Commonwealth of Independent States
- Strategic programming coverage in CEE
- Focus on Western Balkans

Context (why)

- Multi-apartment building with poor energy features built pre-90s represent large percentage of the stock
- Low quality of housing
- Low renovation rate of MABs
- CEE the most energy-poor in Europe.



Program design (how):

- Country assessments;
- Facilitation with key actors and stakeholders;
- Provide support such as technical assistance, information, and resources;
- Advocating, convening, awareness raising, and knowledge management;
- Capital Mobilization.

- ComAct: Community Tailored Actions for Energy Poverty Mitigation
- Justem: JUStice in Transition and EMpowerment against energy poverty
- Sunrise: Prosumer solar energy
- Smarter4EU: Creating “on the ground” operational and self-sustaining Green Homes and Green Mortgage (GHGM) programs
- ComActivate: Enabling community action for energy sufficiency
- Empty Spaces to Homes: renovating vacant buildings
