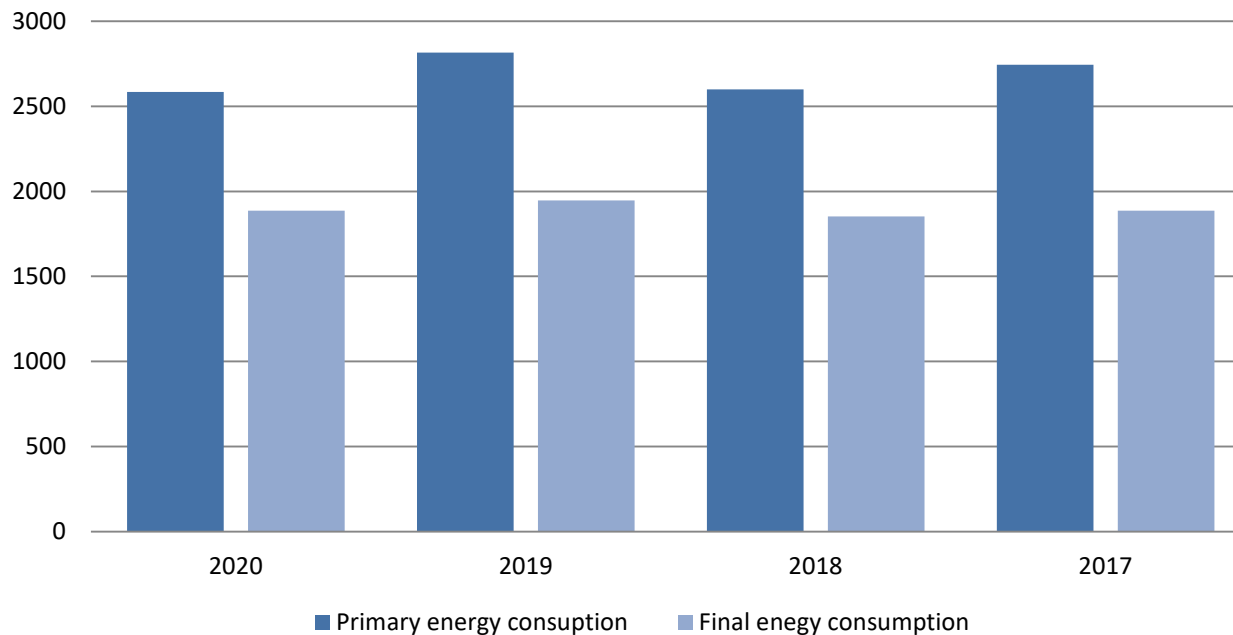

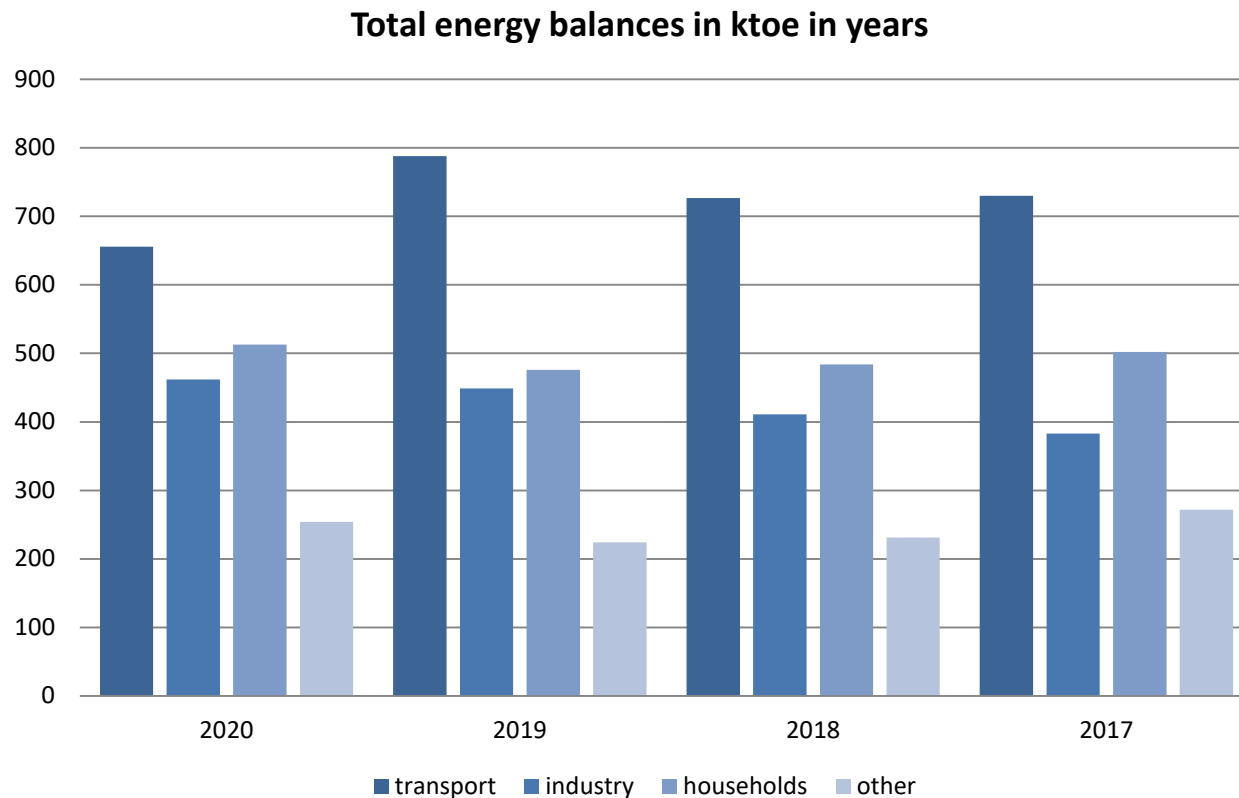
6th Annual Report under the Energy Efficiency Directive

Updates on major energy efficiency measures

- Energy efficiency law (“Official Gazette of Republic of North Macedonia 31/20”)
- Non-legislative measures
 - Program for promotion of energy efficiency and increasing share of RES
 - Reimbursement the costs for installed PVC windows, pellet stoves, solar thermal collectors and PV rooftop - 2007 – ongoing
- Central Government buildings (EED Article 5) and nearly zero-energy buildings (EPBD Article 9)
- Energy efficiency obligations (Article 7)
- Energy audits (Article 8) and energy services (Article 18)
