# Regulatory developments in Serbia #1

05/10/2018 – 05/12/2018

22/11/2018	<p>The Council of the Energy Agency of the Republic of Serbia (AERS) has adopted Agreements on Auction Rules for the Allocation of Cross Zonal Capacities between Bidding Zones of EMS AD and the neighbouring TSOs of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Bulgaria (Coordinated via JAO),</li><li>- Bosnia and Herzegovina, Macedonia and Romania (Joint), and</li><li>- Montenegro and Albania (split 50:50)</li></ul>
29/11/2018	<p>The Council of the Energy Agency of the Republic of Serbia (AERS) has adopted Agreements on Auction Rules for the Allocation of Cross Zonal Capacities between Bidding Zones between EMS AD and the neighbouring TSOs of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Hungary (Joint)</li></ul>
03/12/2018	<p>EMS AD has submitted Agreement on Auction Rules for the Allocation of Cross Zonal Capacities between Bidding Zones between EMS AD and HOPS (Croatia) to AERS for approval (Coordinated via JAO)</p>

# Regulatory developments in Serbia #2

05/10/2018 – 05/12/2018

01/10/2018	<p>On October 1, 2018, the Council of the Energy Agency of the Republic of Serbia (AERS) has adopted a Decision on the Exemption of the New Natural Gas Interconnector thereby approving an exemption to GASTRANS d.o.o. Novi Sad on a future gas pipeline, which will be constructed through the Republic of Serbia and which will be connected to the Bulgarian and Hungarian national transmission systems.</p> <p>In line with the Law (Article 288), this Decision has been submitted by AERS to the Energy Community Secretariat for further action to be taken.</p>
03/10/2018	<p>Secretariat has asked for further clarification on some issues, and AERS` response was submitted to Secretariat on 03 Dec 2018.</p>
