Implementation of the IED in EnC

- *date for **new** plants to implement Chapter III, Annex V and Art 72 (3)-(4) of IED as from 1/1/2018*
- *for **existing** plants, Contracting Parties shall implement those provisions **by 1 January 2028** at the latest.*

Commission Decision of 3.8.2017 on a Proposal for a Recommendation of the Ministerial Council of the EnC

Proposal = to start preparing new Network Energy installations to also apply:

- ***the provisions of Chapters II*** (application of Best Available Techniques and corresponding emission limit values in permits)
- ***Chapter IV and Annex VI*** (minimum requirements and emission limit values for waste (co-)incineration plants)

IED Annex I → Network Energy installations

1.1. Combustion of fuels in installations with a total rated thermal input of 50 MW or more

1.2. Refining of mineral oil and gas

5.2. Disposal or recovery of waste in waste incineration/co-incineration plants:

- (a) for non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 3 t/h;
- (b) for hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 10 t/day.

Chapter IV and Annex VI set minimum requirements and emission limit values for various pollutants for waste (co-)incineration plants irrespective to the capacity class.

 - include required adaptations and appropriate deadlines in view of their effective implementation in the En
- **Decision on inclusion** of Chapters II and IV of the IED in the EnC Treaty
