#### Risk preparedness regulation

- ✓ Ex-post evaluation of electricity crisis.
- More systematic monitoring (ECG) and reporting on MS' performance by ACER.

Common risk identification & assessment Designation of national competent authorities.

- ✓ Common methodologies (developed by ENTSO-E and approved by ACER) for:
  - Identifying electricity crisis scenarios.
  - Assessing short-term adequacy issues.
- ✓ Identification of regional crisis scenarios.

Enhanced monitoring at the EU level

Risk preparedness plans with regional cooperation

- Risk preparedness plans based on common rules, drawn up by the competent authorities:
  - Shall consist of national measures, regional and, where applicable, bilateral measures.
  - Prior consultation of other MSs and the Electricity Coordination Group (ECG).
  - EC can issue opinions on the plans.
  - Plans have to be published.
- EC provides **non-binding guidance** regarding the cooperation and assistance mechanism.

- ✓ Obligation to inform EC and Member States:
  - In case of electricity crisis.
  - "Early-warning".
- ✓ Information on the reasons of crisis, measures and need for assistance.


Information sharing and transparency

Crisis management principles

- Market comes first: non-market measures can be taken only as a last resort measure.
- ✓ Cross-border co-operation and assistance.



#### Main steps towards the final RPPs
